FAITH ROOTS INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY

We opened the doors of Faith Roots International Academy at the CORM Children's Village as an outreach to the communities surrounding us in 2011. Today there are 250 students who attend our school. Many of our students have sponsors who help us provide a quality education to students at little or no cost to their families. Faith Roots is currently ranked the number one school in our district.

"For this reason, I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. 6. Pray that we will have a full teaching staff when school begins.
7. Pray that our students experience the love of Jesus at Faith Roots.
8. Pray for any interns or volunteers who are supposed to work with our school staff this school year, that they will be able to join us.
9. Pray that God provides for our students' families financially.
10. Pray for our students with learning disabilities that they will be healed.
11. Pray that God gives our teachers strategies when dealing with students with behavioral challenges.
12. Pray that our administrators and teachers see their position as a platform for ministry with both the students and their families.
13. Pray that our teachers find joy in their position.
14. Pray that our students return to school ready to learn.
15. Pray that God keeps our students and staff safe.
16. Pray that our parents will be active in their students' education.

GHANA'S CHILD SLAVES

Johnbull and Stacy Omorefe founded the City of Refuge Ministries to provide a home for children who have been rescued from slavery on Lake Volta and other places in Ghana. Lake Volta was created in 1965 to help provide hydroelectricity to Ghana and beyond. The lake has since become the home to an estimated 20,000 child slaves. Children, as young as three are sold to fishermen and made to work for up to 12 hours a day, seven days a week. They are beaten, abused, neglected and alone. The children are malnourished and sleep on the dirt. The boys are forced to dive under the water to untangle fishing nets and many of the children drown when they get caught up in the net. This practice needs to end. We are working with our partners to stop child trafficking at its roots.

1. Pray for children currently trapped in slavery on Lake Volta and other areas in Ghana.
2. Pray for those who are feeling powerless, despair and hopeless that God will give them hope.
3. Pray for God's protection for the children who are in dangerous situations.
4. Pray that the slave children will deeply sense God's love and compassion.
5. Pray for the fishermen that they will see the evil in holding these children. That they will have a desire to reunite the children to their families and repent from their evil ways.
6. Pray that as the CORM Community Impact Teams enter the communities that the people will fully surrender their lives to Christ.
7. Pray that God provides the funds for CORM to build th Missions Outreach Facilities at Lake Volta. We need this as a base to impact more lives for the Kingdom of God.
8. Pray God's protection for the organizations working on the ground to rescue the children from slavery.
9. Pray the children will be healed physically, emotionally and spiritually from the enslavement they have suffered.
10. Pray for those who are enslaved in your area.
11. Pray for Human Trafficking victims around the world
12. Pray for an end to Human Trafficking
13. Pray for God's provision for the City of Refuge to continue to provide quality aftercare and restorative homes for children rescued from slavery.
14. Pray for the family of trafficked victims that their loved ones will be returned to them.
15. Pray for increased awareness about child slavery on Lake Volta and other areas of Ghana.
16. Pray that Ghana's government will confront trafficking and exploitive slavery conditions by dedicating time and resources to eradicating it.
17. Pray that the Body of Christ in Ghana will arise and become a refuge for the children.
18. Pray that the people of Ghana will know education and employment opportunities in place of poverty and will be able to escape the desperate circumstances that make people vulnerable to trafficking and slavery.
19. Pray for better laws and legislation regarding child labor and slavery in Ghana. Pray for enforcement of these laws.
20. Pray for the children who are living in slavery to be rescued – putting an end to their exploitation and abuse.

CORM CHILDREN'S VILLAGE

The CORM Children's Village is located on 20 acres of land donated to CORM by the Chiefs of Doryumu. The children who call the CORM Children's Village their home live in family houses. It is our goal to allow these children to have a childhood since so many of them come out of situations where they were working long hours on fishing boats or doing domestic chores. The children attend school during the day and in the evenings we have activities for them. It is our vision that the CORM Children's Village will be a place of refuge for hundreds of children who are in need of a safe place to call home.

1. Pray that God will make it possible for us to build a clinic, Early Child Education Center, additional Children's Homes and Transitional Housing for our university students over the next two years.
2. Pray each child who calls the CORM Children's Village home or attends Faith Roots will have a personal understanding of the Father's love.
3. Pray each child receives individualized holistic care.
4. Pray that every person at the CORM Children's Village, children and staff, understand their identities in Christ.
5. Pray that the staff will show love and compassion towards every child they encounter.
6. Pray for total restoration of the children's hearts, minds and souls.
7. Pray for the salvation of each child who comes through the CORM Children's Village.
8. Pray for the children who are reunified with their families that God will protect them and provide for them and their families.
9. Pray that as the children go off to Senior High School and University that they will guard their hearts and will seek God in all that they do.
10. Pray that as the children grow that they will have hearts to serve others and to make the love of Christ known.
11. Pray that our caregivers will minister to the children out of hearts of grace, compassion and wisdom.
12. Pray that our staff grow in their relationship with God.
13. Pray for unity among our staff and children.
14. Pray that God expands our staff with like-minded people who have a heart to serve the communities where we work.

GHANA'S VILLAGES AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

The City of Refuge Ministries works with communities to effect lasting change. We desire to bring the love of Jesus into communities vulnerable to selling their children or receiving children as slaves.

The people of the villages where we work tend to worship many gods. We pray that as we love the community leaders and members with the love of Jesus, they will be drawn to Him and accept Him as their Lord and Savior.

1. Pray against malnourishment. One in five children experience stunted growth during their first four years of life. Malnourishment is caused by inadequate nourishment, frequent illness, and an unhealthy environment.
2. Pray for the children who are experiencing a negative impact on their brain development due to malnourishment.
3. Pray that the fetish village leaders will experience Jesus and accept Him as their Lord and Savior.
4. Pray that people begin to understand the importance of education for their children and grandchildren.
5. Pray that schools will open and will be resourced in the villages.
6. Pray against diseases in communities that are suffering from drought.
7. Pray for sustainable income-generating opportunities where poverty is prevalent.
8. Pray that God provides food for the hungry.
9. Pray for clean water in villages that currently do not have access to drinking water.
10. Pray that CORM will expand its interest-free micro-loan program to help more families start and grow their businesses.
11. Pray for God's protection over the children who are vulnerable to being trafficked or sold by their families.
12. Pray that community leaders grow in their relationship with God.
13. Pray for unity amongst community leaders.

20. Pray that the staff know they are loved.

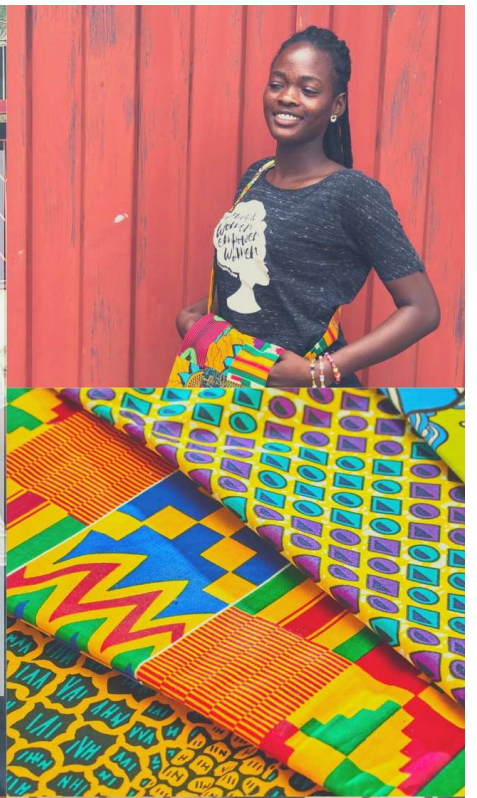

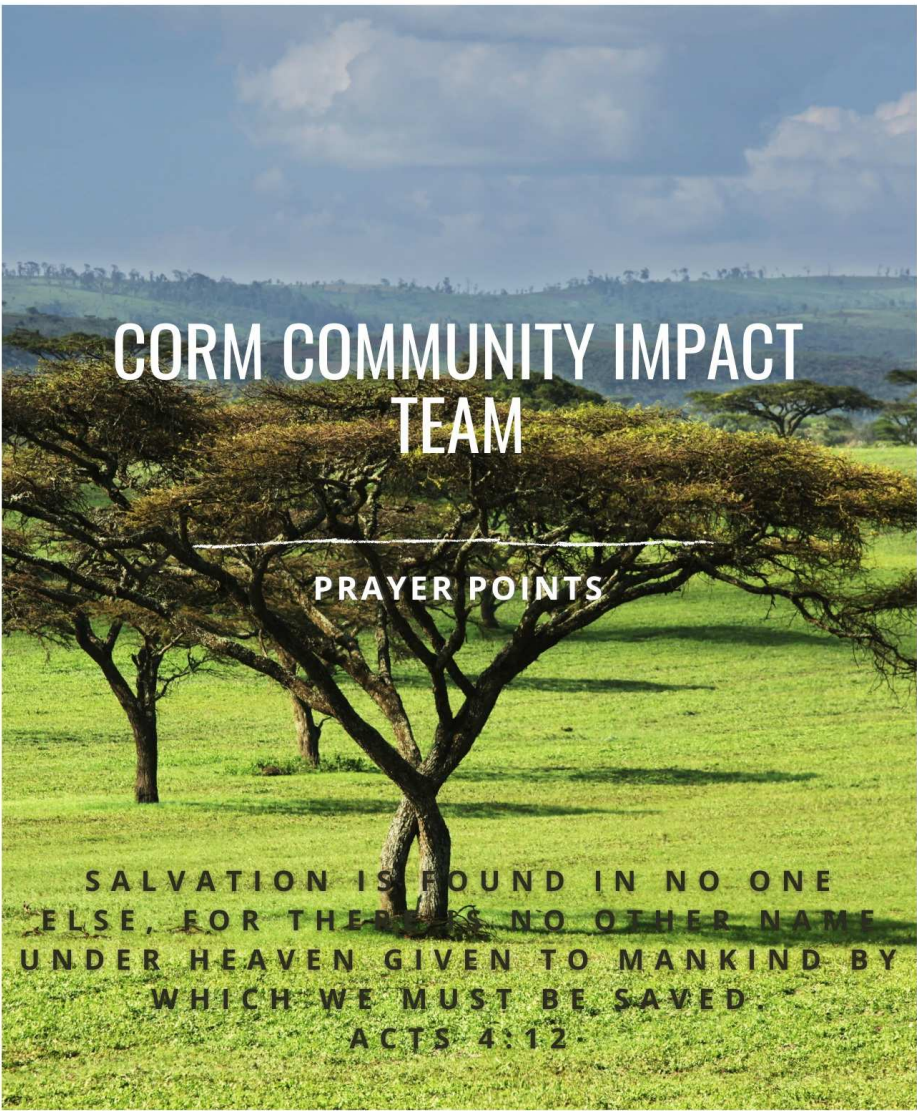
CITY OF REFUGE EMPOWERMENT AND GHANA'S SINGLE MOTHERS

We started City of Refuge Empowerment (CORE) program in 2010 to reach out to the single mothers of Ghana who are vulnerable to selling their children into child slavery. Through CORE we provide single mothers with free housing, free education for their children, sewing skills, discipleship, literacy, parenting, finance and business classes for two years. At the end of the two years the women return to their communities as productive community members, able to provide for their families with a stronger understanding of who they are in Christ. Our current group of ladies will be graduating in 2021.

1. Pray that the ladies who join CORE will accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior.
2. Pray for the staff who are imparting into the lives of the women and their children.
3. Pray against frustration as the ladies learn how to read and write.
4. Pray that the ladies are able to learn sewing skills easily.
5. Pray that the ladies apply the parenting skills that they learn with their children.
6. Pray that the ladies identities will be solid in Jesus Christ.
7. Pray that the women are able to fully understand the business and finance side of their training so they can care for their families needs.
8. Pray that the women understand their worth in Jesus and that they will not become dependent on men for their needs.
9. Pray that after the ladies complete the program that God will open doors for them and their children.
10. Pray for expansion of the CORE program.
11. Pray that will be able to help women in communities around Ghana.
12. Pray for more master seamstresses who will be able to lead CORE programs in their communities.
13. Pray for a market to open in the US and other areas for the CORE products.
14. Pray for Godly husbands for the single mothers. Men who will love their wives and their children well.
15. Pray for strategies in how to enter communities in need of a CORE program.
16. Pray for people with passion for single mothers to join our team.
17. Pray that the Body of Christ in Ghana will arise and become a refuge for the children.

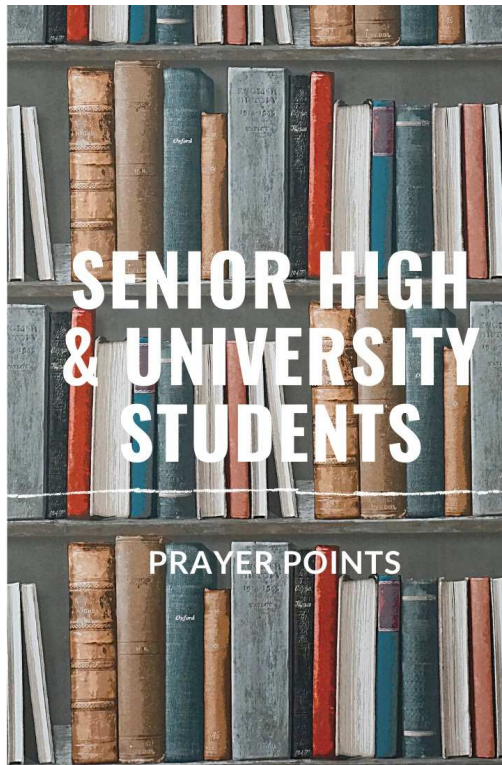
CHILDREN SUFFERING FROM TRAUMA & IN TRAUMATIC SITUATIONS

There are an estimated 20,000 children living as slaves on Ghana's Lake Volta and 152 million children around the world are living their lives in forced labor. These children are living in fear and experiencing great trauma. Our hearts hurt for these children and we want to see each of them free to be children, to learn and to grow in their families.

1. Pray that a child therapist joins our team.
2. Pray that children who have been rescued from slavery will feel safe at the CORM Children's Village.
3. Pray that the children will thrive under their new routines and security.
4. Pray against nightmares and fear.
5. Pray that the children who need to talk through trauma will find an adult they can trust to talk with.
6. Pray for total restoration of the children's hearts, minds and souls.
7. Pray for strategies for us to know how to help each child who has gone through trauma.
8. Pray that God will touch the hearts and minds of the children who have suffered trauma.
9. Pray for the safety of children who are being forced to work in dangerous situations.
10. Pray supernatural protection for children living in traumatic situations.
11. Pray to eradicate the root causes of child exploitation.
12. Pray for an end to human trafficking.
13. Pray for an end to child abuse.
14. Pray for an end to child marriage.
15. Pray for an end to child sacrifice.
16. Pray that the adults who work with children who have gone through trauma will have an understanding of how to help them.
17. Pray that caregivers and social workers would be able to fight discouragement and burn-out by seeking Jesus.
18. Pray that children who are currently suffering in traumatic situations would feel the presence of God.
19. Pray that God will call more laborers into the field of helping children who have been exploited.

Our Senior High and University students leave CORM to their schools and it is our prayer that they are fully prepared to be a light and example to others as they go out into the world.

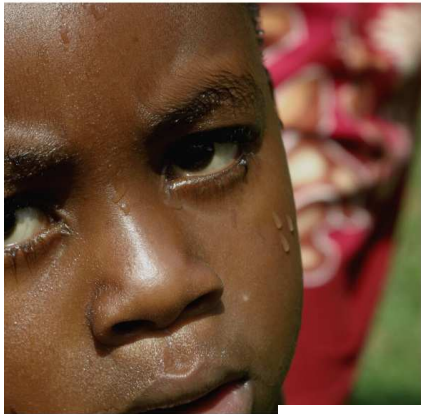
1. Pray for God's protection over our young adults as they leave the CORM Children's Village for school.
